- \*\*Monthly subscriptions; £20 (required no later than the 3<sup>rd</sup> of each month)

*\*registration and Training bundle fees payable by 31-7-19*

*\*\* The monthly subscription fee is apportioned across the 12xmonth period, and accounts for periods of shut down i.e summer break*

### Fines

Please note that all fines imposed by the FA due to infringement of the laws of the game should be paid by the player's parent/guardian. Cautions attract a minimum fine of £10 for a yellow card, for red card offences, the fine imposed will vary depending on the severity of the offence. Delay in payment of these fines will also incur a late payment fee. These fines and late payment fees are set out by the Northamptonshire Football Association in line with their discipline policy.

### Football Kit

Football kit will be provided by the Club and remains the property of the Club at all times. The kit consists of shirt, shorts and socks. Tracksuits and jackets may be provided by a team sponsor or funded by each parent.

Players must provide their own boots and shin guards which must be worn at all matches and training sessions.

### No Smoking Policy.

All spectators, parents, carers, players, and coaches should be aware that the FA has introduced a NO SMOKING RULE at all grassroots football matches and training sessions from the start of 18-19 season.

PLEASE SUPPORT THIS POLICY AND DO NOT SMOKE NEAR THE PLAYERS, please walk far away from where they are playing / training and where possible smoke out of sight. Please note that this now also includes E-cigarettes and Vaping.

As a member of our Club, we would ask that you make everyone within the Club and visiting Club's aware of our No Smoking Policy and ensure that it is adhered to.

### Young Players

**When playing football, I will: I understand that if I do not follow the Code, any/all of the following actions may be taken by my club, County FA or The FA:**

- Always play to the best of my ability and for the benefit of my team
- Play fairly- I won't cheat, dive, complain or waste time
- Respect my team-mates, the other team, the referee or my coach/manager.
- Play by the rules, as directed by the referee
- Be gracious in victory and defeat- I will shake hands with the other team and referee before or at the end of the game
- Listen and respond to what my coach/team manager tells me
- Understand that a coach has to do what is best for the team and not one individual player
- Talk to someone I trust or the club welfare officer if I'm unhappy about anything at my club.

### I may:

- Be required to apologise to my team-mates, the other team, referee or team manager
- Receive a formal warning from the coach or the club committee
- Be dropped or substituted
- Be suspended from training
- Be required to leave the club

### In addition:

- My club may make my parent or carer aware of any infringements of the Code of Conduct

- The FA/County FA could impose a fine and suspension against my club

### Coaches, Team Managers and Club Officials

**We all bear a collective responsibility to set a good example and help provide a positive environment in which children can learn and enjoy the game. Play your part and observe The FA's Respect Code of Conduct at all times.**

### On and off the field, I will:

- Use my position to set a positive example for the people I am responsible for
- Show respect to others involved in the game including match officials, opposition players, coaches, managers, officials and spectators
- Adhere to the laws and spirit of the game
- Promote Fair Play and high standards of behaviour
- Respect the match official's decision
- Never enter the field of play without the referee's permission
- Never engage in, or tolerate, offensive, insulting or abusive language or behaviour
- Be aware of the potential impact of bad language on other participants, facility users or neighbours
- Be gracious in victory and defeat

### When working with players, I will:

- Place the well-being, safety and enjoyment of each player above everything, including winning
- Never engage in or tolerate any form of bullying
- Ensure all activities I organise are appropriate for the players' ability level, age and maturity
- Co-operate fully with others in football (e.g. officials, doctors, physiotherapists, welfare officers) for each player's best interests

**I understand that if I do not follow the Code, any/all of the following actions may be taken by my club, County FA or The FA:**

### I maybe:

- Required to meet with the club, league or County Welfare Officer
- Suspended by the club from attending matches
- Suspended or fined by the County FA
- Required to leave or dismissed by the club
